



HARBOR COVID HEALTH POLICY

Harbor Child Care continues to update and adapt the COVID Health Policy. The policy has been created using guidance from the Office of Children and Family Services (OCFS), Department of Health (DOH) and Center for Disease Control (CDC). The following updated policy will be effective 05/18/2022:

- We accept RAPID, Rapid PCR, or PCR tests from a health care provider. We **do not accept at home tests**.
- Please remember if you, or someone in the household, develop symptoms, please get tested and keep child home until you get your results.
- Person who tests positive
 - Without Symptoms – return on day 6 after positive results with clearance note from doctor.
 - With Symptoms – return after day 10 with no symptoms and clearance note from doctor.
- Home Exposure to a person who tests positive
 - Test 5 days after positive results from household member.
 - If negative may return on day 6 with test results.
 - If positive follows above section titled ‘Person who tests positive’.
- Classroom Exposure to a person who tests positive
 - Classroom(s) will remain open unless otherwise indicated.
 - Families will receive an email indicating that their child has come into contact with a person that has tested positive.
 - The Health Alert for COVID will be attached to the email with symptoms to look out for.
 - Parents are to monitor their children for symptoms and to seek testing/doctor's clearance if symptomatic.
 - Staff will monitor children for symptoms. Parent/Guardian will be notified, and protocol followed.
- For **Travel**- Please let us know if and when you will be traveling INTERNATIONALLY. Harbor’s policy is that your child quarantine for a minimum of 3 days, monitor symptoms, and return with a negative COVID test. **At home test will not be accepted.**
- Please note the testing date is counted as day 0.
